## **Rose Bud All Minis Show March 13, 2010 Rules and Regulations**

**Please make checks and money orders payable to Amy Elkins.**

1. Time: Setup: 7:00 am Show begins at 8:00 am SHARP.
2. Location: Camas Community Center, 1718 SE 7th Ave, Camas, WA.
3. Eligibility: This show is open to anyone to enter (no membership required) and to all brands & types (plastic, china, etc.) of models, figurines or statues that are Little Bits scale or smaller. Judges shall not compete in classes they are judging. Show management and/or their relatives shall not compete. A judge who customized a model shall not judge that model in any class.
4. DEFINITION OF DIVISIONS:  
General: all normal model horse show rules apply. Each model may enter 1 breed halter class only. No cross-entering of halter divisions.  
OPEN SIMPLE CUSTOM (SCM): For models that have been touched-up, repainted, slightly remade, haired or any combination of these; artist resins, original sculptures, and drastically repositioned or sculpted models shall NOT compete in this division. Please see Drastic CM/AR.  
OPEN DRASTIC CM / ARTIST RESIN (CM/AR): For models that have been drastically repositioned or sculpted and any artist resins & original sculptures shall compete in this division.  
OPEN ORIGINAL FINISH: For factory finish models, no touched-up models (added socks, blazes, etc.) allowed; models that have been rubbed with baby oil or similar product will be penalized or disqualified at the judge's discretion. Open to plastic models only. Minis shall compete in their own division.  
COLLECTABILITY: Same rules as Open Original Finish. OF horses may cross enter into this division as well as their halter division.  
WORKMANSHIP: Same rules as CM classes above. CM horses may cross enter into this division as well as their halter division.
5. Basic Judging Criteria: OF Halter: condition, conformation, breed type, color (not value, collectability, rarity or age). CM Halter: condition, conformation, breed type, color, workmanship. Collectability: rarity, collectability, condition, age, and value. Workmanship: quality of sculpting, painting, shading, and detail work done on custom models.
6. Breed Halter Classes: Judges, at their discretion, will use the Breed Type guide for breed definition for the purpose of deciding in what class to enter a horse. You may view this guide to better assist you in placing your horses: <http://www.modelhorsegallery.info/library/breedtype.html>
7. Halters: Are not required in breed, or foal classes; if used, should fit properly and be appropriate for the breed.
8. Foals/Yearlings: May enter foal/yearling breed classes only. They may also enter their appropriate Collectability or Workmanship class.

9. Entry Limit: No Limits. The suggested limit is not more than 50 models per entrant.

10. Class limit: 4 models per entrant in Breed Halter, and 2 in Collectability/Workmanship Classes unless otherwise stated.

11. Leg Tags: You must provide and fill out your own tags. You must provide a list of models with tag numbers to the show holder prior to the show, or on show day.

String tags should be at least 1"

Each entrant will be assigned an exhibitor identification code (Tag Saver Program is allowed, and preferred.)

You must provide an e-mail address or a SASE to get your code.

Make list of your models; number them sequentially starting with 1

Mark your tags with your code letter, model number and model's breed

Example, if Code = K, Model # = 12, and Breed = Morgan

K-12

Morgan

Please print neatly on tags in blue or black ink

12. Judges: To be announced

13. Awards: Ribbons are available for places 1 through 6. Laminated flats will be used in show rings. Rosettes for Champion and Reserve Champ, rosettes for Grand and Reserve. Any other items to be announced.

14. Results: Results (1st - 6th only) sent to all entrants requesting them after show (e-mail or US mail). SASE to be provided by entrant.

15. NAMSHA Member Show: 1st & 2nd place models in Custom, China, and OF divisions will receive tickets & qualify to compete at North American Nationals (NAN) in 2010 & 2011. Models that qualify in halter can enter halter at NAN; those that qualify in performance can enter performance at NAN. Owners of qualified models must contact NAMHSA for entry forms/procedures. NAMHSA will announce when to do so.

16. Class Order: All Divisions will be judged simultaneously on separate tables. Table markers will indicate division and class for each table. Halter and Performance divisions will run consecutively in a manner to allow horses to compete in both.

17. Time Limits: 3 minutes maximum preceding halter classes; 7 minutes maximum preceding performance classes. Judges will be asked to enforce time limits.

18. Raffle/Auctions: Donations are welcome! Donors of auction/raffle items get a half-page ad in show program and mention on the RCL website. Raffle ticket price will be announced on show day.

To place an ad in the show program, fill out the appropriate section on the entry form and send in with your copy ready ad, entry and payment. If you are donating a raffle or auction item and are getting a free ad, send your copy ready ad with your entry and do not remit payment for the ad.

19. Selling/Trading: You may display models, tack, etc. for sale or trade on your table; sales only tables are \$20 each

20. Entering/Deadlines: Print the entry form from the Entry Form page, fill it out and mail it. Fees are listed on it. Entries due by February 25, 2010. Entries may be received, with proper late fees, up until the day of the show, permitting there is available space. Entries made on show day will be charged \$10 extra per person. There are a set number of tables available, late entries may need to share table space, or may be turned away.

21. Adding/Changing Models: Any changes/additions must be provided in writing to the show-holder on show-day.

22. Lunch: We will break around noon for 1 hour regardless of where we are on class-list. Lunch will be made available on a pre-order basis only. Please plan to either pre-order your lunch from us, bring your own lunch, or take advantage of the many restaurants available in the area during the break. Lunch will be provided for judges.

23. Proxy Showing: Proxy showers are welcome and must conform to the same entry guidelines as other entrants. Either the per-horse fee, or an unlimited fee of \$35, whichever is less, should be followed for proxy entries. All proxy horse lists should be mailed with your entry prior to the show.

24. Alcohol: Absolutely no alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the show hall.

25. Animals: Live animals are not allowed in this building, with the exception of “working dogs” (ie: Seeing Eye dogs).

26. Children: Children are welcome to attend under adult supervision. Any unattended children will be sold at auction.

All Items are subject to be changed or revised as show date and details become closer.
